

# More Than 100 Tractors Completed by TEMCO

TEMCO's tractor program is well organized and producing as many tractors as the availability of parts will permit at this time.

Leon Mason, who heads this project for TEMCO, reports that present schedule calls for the completion of ten tractors daily. This tractor is being assembled by TEMCO for the Intercontinental Mfg. Company headed by Harold J. Silver of New

TEMCO, in addition to completing the assembly of this large tractor, also fabricates sheet metal parts, such as the hood, side panels, radiator shell, gas tank support, instrument panel, etc.

The initial contract between TEMCO and Intercontinental Manufacturing Company calls for the completion of 2,000 of these power tractors.



## Another New Product to Be Built by TEMCO

In the very near future all military aircraft will have a component manufactured by TEMCO installed in them. The unit is known as a Position Light-Code Flasher. Technically is is an electrical timing device, consisting of a constant speed D. C. Motor, which drives a series of cams that control individual switches for exterior positions, lights on the wings, tail and fuselage. This device controls the light flashes emitted and can be used for coded recognition automatically when radio silence is necessary, or as a safety measure at night when standard flashing requirements are necessary. This, mechanism was developed by W. R. Lightbody, Inc. of New York City, and a represen ative from that company is currently at TEMCO to lend tech-

nical advice in the production development of the unit.

The Air Force awarded TEMCO an initial contract for approximately 500 of these units and it is expected that deliveries will start in October.


